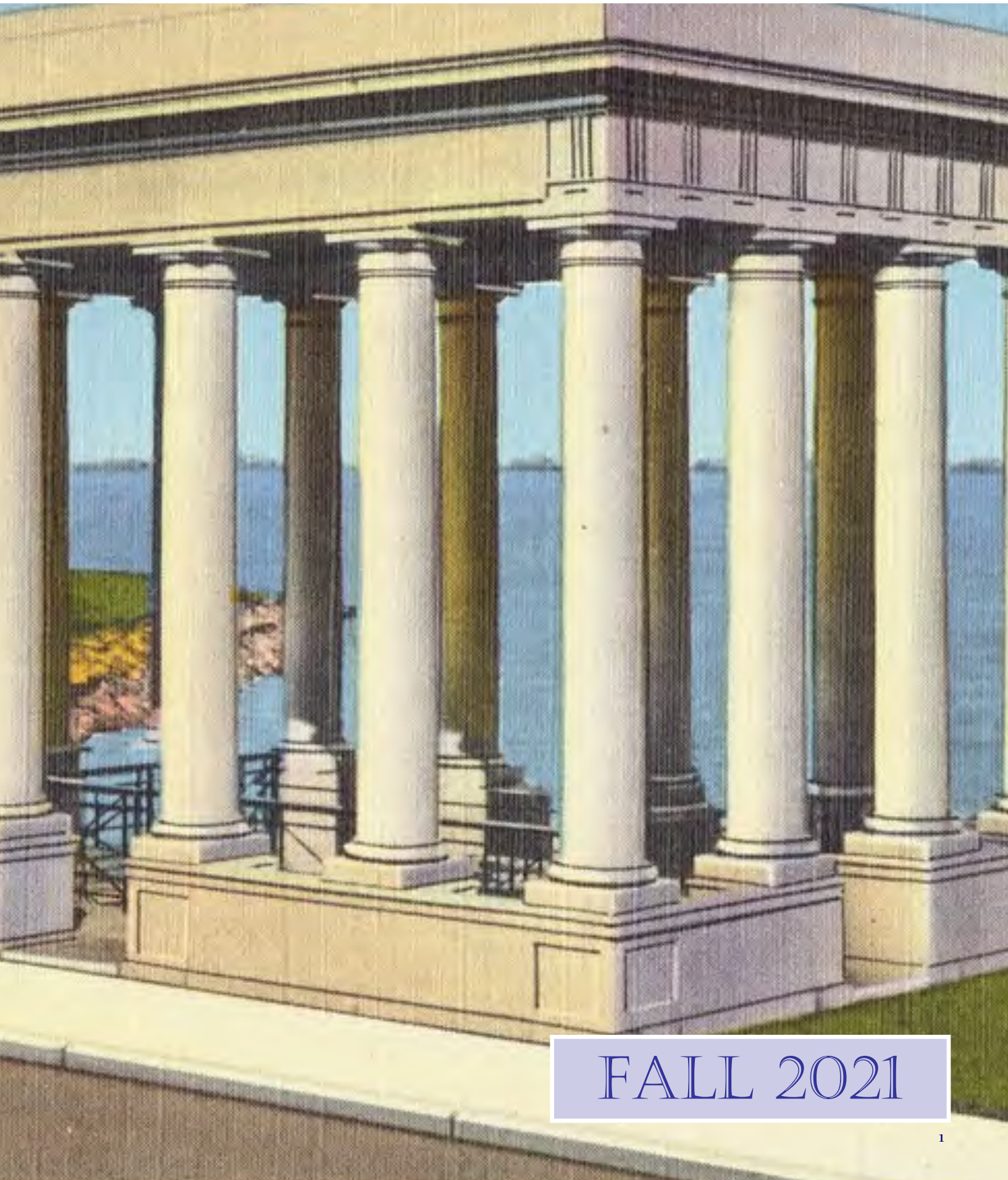

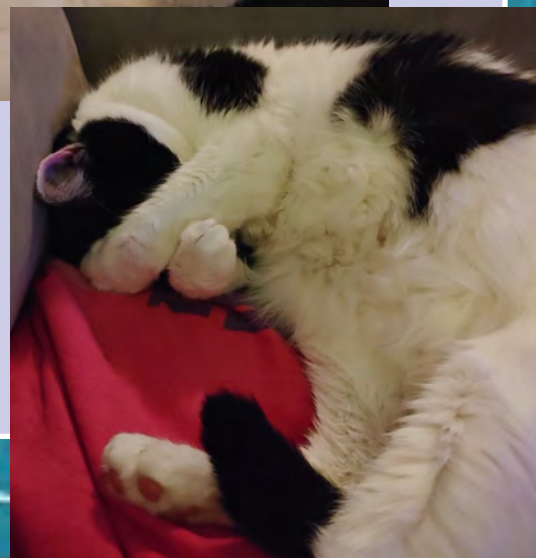
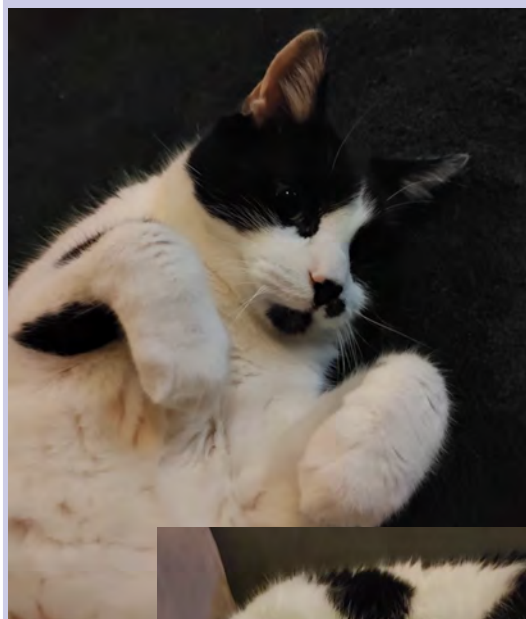
Fiona and *Shrek* are now separated into two tanks due to the development of a fungus on *Fiona's* skin.
